4. **Update your voter registration.** If you wish to vote for Art, you must be registered a Republican. If you are registered as a Democrat or Independent/Third Party, you can change your registration to Republican but must do so by Friday, May 29. You can always change your registration back to the party or no party of your choice after the election. Also, you should make sure your address is correct and update your signature.

5. **Vote.** The special election, held in the Summer (Tuesday, June 30). As such voter turnout will be low. The side that gets their voters out will win. Make sure you vote. If you will be out of town for July 4th celebrations or travel plans, vote early or request an absentee ballot.
